Trip Details

Day 1-2

Arrive at Maun airport, where you will be personally greeted upon arrival. Then by road we head to our first camp, here you can relax and enjoy the vast views over the Boteti River where wildlife concentrates to drink and elephants spend hours swimming and playing.

Start the morning with a light breakfast, followed by either a walking safari with experienced Bushman, viewing wildlife activity along the banks of the Boteti River. Or for those who would prefer to see the game from our very comfortable vehicles, we can provide game drives into Makgadikgadi and Nxai Pans National Park.



Day 3-5



We will then head back to Maun airport where you will hop on a 30 min private charter flight to the next camp. The tented camp is nestled on a lush palm island in the heart of the northern Okavango Delta. An intimate, classic camp located on the edge of a lagoon, which simply teems with animal and birdlife. Every possible comfort has been catered for, a truly luxurious experience in the heart of the delta.

Courtesy of its location the camp can offer both water and land activities year round. Motorboats or Mokoro provide a chance to experience the incredible bird, plant and reptile species found in the aquatic habitat of the Okavango Delta. Game drives are conducted by a personal guide in comfortable, specially designed game drive vehicles. For the more adventurous, guided walks are also available while fishing enthusiasts will enjoy fishing for a variety of species such as tilapia and tiger fish.

Day 6-8



We will then charter fly another 30 mins to Savute. Savute is a remote and wild corner of the Chobe National Park, situated south of the Chobe River. The area's main feature is the mysterious Savute Channel, which flows and dries up seemingly unrelated to the rainfall. Dry and arid for almost 30 years, animals in the area were sustained by artificial waterholes.

With the Savute Channel having started flowing again in recent years, the region has undergone a startling transformation, reverting to its natural lush and marshy state. Here you will see large numbers of wildlife that have been attracted to this rejuvenated wilderness haven. This area is renowned for its population of large bull elephant and for the unique interaction of the resident predator species.

All suites at this lodge have private decks, combined bedroom and sitting areas and en-suite facilities. The sitting area, library and cocktail bar are situated in an exquisite thatch and timber main building. The lodge also boasts a viewing deck, an al fresco dining area and swimming pool – which is ideal for watching game at the waterhole. These features set the lodge apart from other typical safari destinations.

Activities will include game drives conducted in the Savute area, including the famous Savute Marsh, and the ancient San rock paintings at Gubatsa Hills, adding magic to your African safari.

Day 9-10

From Savute we will travel by safari vehicle 3 hours through the national park a wonderful drive in itself! Arriving at Chobe National Park, the lodge overlooks the Chobe River and the Caprivi floodplains. The iconic lodge is the only permanent safari lodge within the Chobe National Park. Rooms are river-facing, and include minibars, en-suite bathrooms, tea and coffee making facilities as well as private terraces. In addition, four exclusive suites have their own plunge pools and separate lounges.

All safari activities are tailored to suit your individual requirements. Game drives, game viewing by small boats, sunset cruises along the Chobe River and after-dinner stargazing are offered. A truly magical place with 5 star comfort.



Day 11-12



From Chobe National Park, we will then drive 1.5 hours to Victoria Falls crossing over into Zimbabwe. Here you will arrive at a luxurious safari lodge, set high on a natural plateau, bordering the Zambezi National Park and just four kilometres from the thundering Victoria Falls, Southern Africa's foremost attraction and one of the seventh wonders of the world.

Here you can enjoy uninterrupted views of spectacular African sunsets and year round game viewing at the lodge's on-site waterhole. You will find a huge range of different activities on offer in Victoria Falls, and not to mention the awe inspiring falls itself!
